Camp Pagweak General Behaviour Policy For Rental Guests

- A. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco and prohibited drugs are not permitted on Camp property.
- B. Physical aggression towards another person is not acceptable behavior. (Examples: fighting, hitting. kicking. etc.)
- C. Proper language and manners are expected at all times.
- D. Racial, gender, and cultural differences and disabilities will be respected.
- E. Treat your fellow guests and Pagweak staff with the same dignity and common courtesy as you would desire for yourself.
- F. Please respect the privacy and belongings of others. No "borrowing"
- G. Treat the facilities and equipment of Camp Pagweak as your own and if you return it or leave the property leave the facilities and equipment in the same condition you found it. (Note: Any intentional damage to any of the camp facilities and/or equipment will be added to the cost of the rental.
- H. The following areas are out of bounds for your safety and protection; the waterfront, woods, highway, campfire area, staff cabins & rooms and neighboring cottages unless accompanied by a staff member or during camp activities.
- I. Suitable footwear must be worn at all times when outside of cabins, shower or at beach.
- J. All stones are to remain on the ground (NO ROCK THROWING)
- K. Please report accidents to the Camp Director.
- L. In the event that the smoke detectors or siren are activated. follow this procedure:
 - a. Go quickly and directly to the sports field
 - b. Assemble with your cabin group
 - c. Stay calm, quiet, and together. Never re-enter the Lodge or cabins until instructed by the Camp Director.
